## **Inflation Report, December 2017**

## A. Domestic Inflation

In December 2017, Phnom Penh Consumer Price Index increased by 0.4% compared to previous month and 2.2% compared to previous year.

In 2017, inflation rate (year on year) is 2.2% lower than previous year rate of 3.9% and inflation rate (year average) is 2.9% lower than previous year rate of 3%. By the observation, inflation significantly increased in the first semester of 2017 due to the increase of food and clothes price, adding the reverse back of gasoline and desiel price. However, from the second semester inflation increased moderately due to the moderate growth of some product groups, such as clothes, alcoholic beverage and tobacco, furnishings, health, especially food (meats, fish, vegetable, and fruit) which cover 44% of the whole basket goods weight.

To sum up, in 2017 inflation in Cambodia remain in good situation and stay in the manageable level, in which can push up the domestic production, and also contribute to stablizing the macroeconomic growth.

- Generally, the prices are collected from four sample stands in each market
- For items that are not sold in the market, prices are collected from nearby stores
- The Price Indices are compiled by geometric average
