Inflation Report, October 2017

A. Domestic Inflation

In October 2017, Phnom Penh Consumer Price Index decreased by 0.2% compared to previous month; however, it increased by 2.1% compared to previous year.

In October 2017, most of product groups decreased notably compared to the September, such as Price level of foods and nonalcoholic beverages, clothing and footwear, Communication, and Education. However, Price level of alcoholic beverages and tobacco and Price level of restaurant rose at the same rate of 0.5%. Also, Price level transport increased 0.2%.

Price level of some product groups, such as Price level of restaurant, Price level of transport, Price level of clothing and footwear, Price level of food and nonalcholic beverages, and Price level of alcoholic beverage and tobacco increased compare to the same period last year. Price level of transport rose by 3.7%; this growth rate was lower than the grwoth in August and September, in which gasoline price and diesel price increased 7.6% and 7.2%, respectively.

By the estimation till December 2017, inflation rate year-on-year is approximately 1.4%, and year average inflation rate is approximately 2.8%.

- For items that are not sold in the market, prices are collected from nearby stores
- The Price Indices are compiled by geometric average
